This was an action to recover the sum of twenty Pounds and also the sum of Twenty Pounds by a subsequent writ, the whole being for half a years rent of a dwelling house the possession of which was given by Plaintiff to defendant on the first day of May last, on a verbal agreement.

The defendant stated that the Plaintiff had not performed his part of the agreement, the Court expressed a wish that all agreements of this kind for or between Landlord and tenant should be reduced into writing and signed by the parties, and declines settling the business for want of proof.
