and other Matters now depending between him and the said
Deceased he conceives it necessary to apply to your Honor
for Letters of Administration and which he flatters himself You
will grant him accordingly, and he will as in Duty bound

You shall swear that you believe Peter Winsor
late of this place Plaintiff deceased died Intestate and
without a Will; and that you will well and truly administer
all and singular the goods Debts Credits and Effects of the
Deceased, as far as such Goods Debts Chattels, Credits and
Effects will thereto Extend and the Law will require;

and that you will when called upon Exhibit a just and
Faithful account of such your Administration; and that
you are the Lawful and right Cousin and next of kin
of and unto Peter Winsor so Deceased as aforesaid;

And that the whole of the Goods Debts, Credits and Effects
of the said Deceased do not in Value Exceed the Sum of
one hundred pounds Sterling, to the best of your knowledge
and belief. So help you God!

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if
the abovesaid Peter Winsor his Exors, Adors or assigns do
make or cause to be made a just, True and perfect Inventory
or Schedule of all and singular the Goods Debts Credits and
Effects of the said Deceased, which already have or that
hereafter shall come to the hands, knowledge or Possession
of him the said Peter Winsor, or to the hands, knowledge or
Possession of any other Person or Person for him, and the same
do Exhibit or cause to be Exhibited into the Registry
of the said Court on or before the Fifteenth Day of Novr
now next ensuing. - and further do make a just and
True account of such administration on or before the
Twentieth Day of November aforesaid and all the Rest

Greetings

Whereas Peter Winsor late of this place Boathooker, Deceased, and as is allodged Died Intestate and without a Will, having whilst living and at the Time of his Death sundry Goods, Debts Credits Chattles and Effects in Newfoundland aforesaid by Reason whereof the sole ordering and granting of Administration of all and singular the said Goods and Chattles, Debts and Effects of the said Deceased, and also the allowing auditing and final Discharging the amount thereof are well known to belong and appertain wholly to our said Supreme Court, and we being Demous that the said Goods and Chattles Debts and Effects of the said Deceased may be well and faithfully Administered & Disposed of according to Law DO by these presents grant full power & authority unto You in whose Fidelity We Confide to Administer & Dispose of the said Goods Debts Credits and Effects, and to ask, Demand, Sue for Recover and Receive of and from all and every person and persons whatsoever Debt or Debts which whilst living or at the Time of his Death did any way belong to him the said Deceased, and also to Pay whatever Debts that the said Deceased did at the Time of his Death owe. so far as such Goods, Debts, Credits &
