Now know all Men by these presents, that I the said Deputy Sheriff, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Pounds Ten shillings currency of this Island, to me in hand paid by Elizabeth Finn of Cape Broyle at and before the sealing and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Elizabeth Finn all and singular the goods and chattels following by me taken in execution by virtue of

the said Unit of Five Acres, that is to say, said John O'Brien right, title, and interest to and in a certain Plantation situated at the head of Caplin Bay, commonly called Brown More and lately in the occupancy of the said John O'Brien, which of the said Deputy Sheriff at the sealing and delivery hereof, have delivered to the said Elizabeth Finn to have and to hold the same unto the said Elizabeth Finn her executors, administrators and assigns and as her and their own property, to her and their own use and benefit forever. In witness whereof the said Deputy Sheriff have hereunto set my Hand and Seal of Office at Ferryland in the Southern District of Newfoundland the Ninth day of November in the First year of the Reign of Her Majesty William the Fourth and in the year of our Lord 1830
