Central District of the Island of Newfoundland on  
the twenty third day of November in the year of our  
Lord One Thousand eight hundred and thirty five  
between Michael Doveaux of Ferryland in the  
Southern District of the said Island of the one part  
and James McBride and Robert Kerr of St. Johns  
aforesaid of the other part - Witnessing that the said  
Michael Doveaux for and in consideration of  
the sum of Ten shillings to him in hand paid -  
and One hundred Pounds of lawful Money of Great  
Britain part of a debt owing to the said James  
McBride and Robert Kerr, did by the said Indenture  
assign, transfer and set over unto the said James  
McBride and Robert Kerr their Heirs and Assigns the  
Residue and Remainder of a Term of which fourteen years  
were unexpired on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October last in certain  
Premises situate in Ferryland aforesaid, and commonly  
called & known by the name of "Robert's Room", held under  
Lease from Richard Roberts, or James H. Carter his  
lawful attorney - To have and to hold the same unto the  
said James McBride & Robert Kerr - their Heirs, Executors administrators  
and assigns for the residue of the Term aforesaid. In Witness  
whereof the party to the said Indenture had therunto come  
set his hand & Seal on the day & year aforesaid.

Memorial of a Deed of assignment <sup>or bargain & sale</sup> made at St. Thomas in Central District of the Island of Newfoundland on the twenty third day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirty five between Michael Devareux of Ferryland in the Southern District of Newfoundland of the one part and James McBride and Robert Kerr of St. Johns on the other parts Witnessing that the said Michael Devareux for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred & fifty pounds Sterling part of debt now due and owing to the said James McBride and Robert Kerr - and in consideration of the sum of Ten Shillings Sterling to him in hand paid by the said James McBride and Robert Kerr, did by the said James McBride and Robert Kerr - All the Goods, Boats, Nets, Lines, Fishing-craft, Fishing utensils and Cattle and all other Goods & Chattels whatsoever mentioned in a Schedule annexed to the said Indenture. to have and to hold the said Goods, Boats, Nets, Lines, Fishing-craft, Fishing utensils Cattle and other Goods and Chattels now remaining at Ferryland aforesaid, unto the said James McBride and Robert Kerr and to their proper use and benefit their Executors administrators and assigns for ever.
