Know all men by these presents that I Edmond Healy of Halifax Bay Newfoundland for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen pounds Currency to me in hand at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents paid by Robert Carter the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the said Robert Carter my Field and Garden situate on the North West side of Trinity and the Field on the North West side of a Public Road leading to the Gaze and the Garden on the South side of a Public Road leading to the Gaze and specified in the Diagram in the Grant delivered to R Carter To have and to hold the said Bargained and sold Field and Garden unto the said Robert Carter his Executors Administrators and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Robert Carter his Executors Administrators and assigns for ever, And the said Edmond Healy for himself his Executors Administrators the said hereby bargained Field and Garden unto the said Robert Carter his Executors Administrators and assigns against all persons shall and will lawfully and for ever defend by these presents I will testify whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal in Newfoundland Newfoundland this third day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six
